Effective immediately, the Court finds:

The Ottawa County Municipal Court has revised the following measures:

- Social distancing (maintaining a distance of 6 feet) will remain in effect whenever possible.
- Masks are encouraged but NOT REQUIRED.
- If you are experiencing ANY symptoms of an illness, feel sick, or if you are running an abnormal temperature (or a temperature above 99 degrees), you should immediately leave the court house and call the clerk's office.
- THE COURT HOUSE IS NOW FULLY OPEN TO THE PUBLIC.
- As always: sanitize your hands; avoid close contact with others; avoid touching eyes, nose and mouth; cover coughing and sneezing; no handshaking.

The health and safety of our staff and public remains our number one priority. Thank you for your cooperation with these policies and continue to do everything you can to keep yourself, your family and the general public safe.
